REQUIREMENTS ALABAMA JUNIOR ANGUS ASSOCIATION JUNIOR AND SENIOR QUEENS

- 1. The age limits set by the National Junior Association for showing will be used for the age limits of the Queens. These ages are Juniors, 9 to 14 as of January 1st. Seniors, 14 to 21 as of January 1st.
- 2. Preference will be given to those who have not previously served as a Queen.
- 3. Money given by the Women's Association will be reimbursed in a lump sum upon presentation of the receipts up to a total of \$250.00.
- 4. The money awarded by the Women's Association will be used for clothes and personal expenses for the Queens expenses during the time that the Queens serve. The clothes and expenses must be things that will help the Queens carry out their duty.
- 5. The winners must be present on Field Day of the presentation of the award.
- 6. Only activities relating to Angus cattle and no other breeds will be considered in the selection of the Queen.
- 7. First priority will be given to those applicants whose mothers are members of the Alabama Angus Women's Association.
- 8. Applications must be turned into the Women's Association by the annual meeting in April (the same as the spring sale in Cullman).
- 9. The queens must attend the National Junior Show and participate in the following:
 - a. Queen's luncheon or brunch
 - b. Opening ceremony where you should be properly dressed (crown and banner)
 - c. Helping to pass out ribbons and for pictures some time during the week where you should be properly dressed (crown and banner)

- 10. The shows where the Queens attend and help pass out ribbons and in pictures, a copy of pictures are to be presented to Alabama Angus Women's Association.
- 11. Failure to meet the above requirements will result in the forfeit of the title and crown.
